PURPOSE:

To define the Central DuPage Hospital Emergency Medical Services (CDHEMSS) requirements for Emergency Communication Radio Nurse (ECRN) instructors for classes offered by CDHEMSS.

POLICY:

1. All instructors of ECRN programs under the oversight of the CDHEMSS must meet the following criteria, in addition to the requirements of the program's employer:
 - a. Have and maintain an Illinois Lead Instructor License (program coordinator only)
 - b. Adjunct instructors shall be in good standing within the CDHEMSS as an EMT, EMT-P, EMD, ECRN or PHRN.
 - c. Have at least 5 years experience in ED/EMS

2. Instructor's class pass rates will be monitored by the CDHEMSS Medical Director. Should an instructor(s) have a class with a failure rate of:
 - a. 25-49%, said instructor(s) will meet with the CDHEMSS Medical Director and or the EMS Coordinator to address the pass rates.
 - b. 50% or greater. The instructor(s) will not be permitted to instruct another class under the CDHEMSS pending a reevaluation by EMS Medical Director and EMS System Coordinator. The stay on education shall have no bearing on other aspects of the Instructors profession.

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
