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PURPOSE:

To define the Central DuPage Hospital Emergency Medical Services (CDHEMSS) requirements for Pre-Hospital Registered Nurse (PHRN) training course offered by CDHEMSS.

POLICY:

1. All instructors of ECRN programs under the oversight of the CDHEMSS must meet the requirements of the "PHRN Instructor" policy.
2. All programs will be in compliance with IDPH regulations as well as Region 8 PHRN training requirements.
3. Prior to the authorization of a PHRN course, the site code application will be reviewed by the EMS Medical Director and EMS System Coordinator. Upon approval of the course, the application will be forwarded to the IDPH Region 8 EMS Coordinator for site code approval.
 - a. Course application not approved by CDHEMSS will be returned to the Lead Instructor (LI) who submitted the application with reason for denial. The LI has the opportunity to correct the reasons for denial and resubmit to the CDHEMSS.
4. Academic Requirements
 - a. PHRN candidates must pass the final written exam with $\geq 80\%$.
 - b. PHRN candidates shall attend each full day of class
 - c. PHRN candidates shall complete the extrication awareness aspect of the PHRN class
 - d. Upon passing the classroom portion of the PHRN class the PHRN candidate must ride and obtain 20 ALS calls with a CDHEMSS Fire Department
5. Licensing
 - a. Upon completion of the above listed requirements the PHRN's IDPH transaction card can be sent to IDPH for processing **and state exam**. The PHRN may NOT render care in the pre-hospital setting until a copy of their license has been submitted to the CDHEMSS office.
