**PURPOSE:**

To define the minimum requirements for a Central DuPage Hospital Emergency Medical Services System (CDHEMSS) provider to be deemed in “Good Standing” within the CDHEMSS.

**POLICY:**

EMS providers within the CDHEMSS must be in “Good Standing” for the following actions to take place by the CDHEMSS office:

1. Letters of Good Standing
2. Downgrade of licensure
3. Request for inactive status
4. Re-licensure

The minimum requirements to be considered in “Good Standing” for each licensure level include:

1. EMD
  - a. Complete each system approved EMD Continuing Education (CE)
  - b. Complete any Medical Director mandated education by deadline
  - c. Be under no current disciplinary action
  - d. Have a current Healthcare Provider CPR card
  - e. Have a current IDPH EMD license
  - f. Continuously active within the system, with no inactive periods of greater than 90 days
2. EMT-B
  - a. Complete each system offered Continuing Education (CE) skills education
  - b. Complete any Medical Director mandated education by deadline
  - c. Be under no current disciplinary action
  - d. Have a current Healthcare Provider CPR card
  - e. Have a current IDPH EMT-B license
  - f. Have met the annual skills requirements for EMT-B's
  - g. Continuously active within the system, with no inactive periods of greater than 90 days
  - h. By January 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 have and maintain:
    - i. PEARS
    - ii. PHTLS

3. EMT-P

- a. Complete each system offered Continuing Education (CE) skills education
- b. Complete any Medical Director mandated education by deadline
  - i. All quarterly intubations
- c. Be under no current disciplinary action
- d. Have a current Healthcare Provider CPR card
- e. Have a current IDPH EMT-P license
- f. Have met the annual skills requirements for EMT-P's
- g. Continuously active within the system, with no inactive periods of greater than 90 days
- h. By January 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 have and maintain:
  - i. PALS
  - ii. PHTLS
  - iii. ACLS

4. ECRN

- a. Complete each system offered Continuing Education (CE) PowerPoint and quiz
- b. Complete any Medical Director mandated education by deadline
- c. Be under no current disciplinary action
- d. Have a current Healthcare Provider CPR card
- e. Have a current IDPH ECRN license
- f. Complete annual CarePoint competency
- g. Complete annual ride time requirements by deadline
- h. Continuously active within the system, with no inactive periods of greater than 90 days

5. PHRN (BLS or ALS licensed vehicle provides)

- a. Complete each system offered Continuing Education (CE) skills education
- b. Complete any Medical Director mandated education by deadline
  - i. All quarterly intubations
- c. Be under no current disciplinary action
- d. Have a current Healthcare Provider CPR card
- e. Have a current IDPH PHRN license
- f. Have met the annual skills requirements for PHRN's.
- g. Continuously active within the system, with no inactive periods of greater than 90 days
- h. By January 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 have and maintain:
  - i. PALS
  - ii. PHTLS
  - iii. ACLS

6. Critical Care Paramedic (tier 2-3 EMS licensed vehicle providers)

- a. Complete each system offered Continuing Education (CE) skills education
- b. Complete any Medical Director mandated education by deadline
  - i. All quarterly intubations
- c. Complete 12 hours of Critical Care Education annually
- d. Complete skills competencies annually
- e. Be under no current disciplinary action

- f. Have a current Healthcare Provider CPR card
  - g. Have a current IDPH EMT-P license as well as a current Critical Care certification
  - h. Have met the annual skills requirements for Critical Care Paramedics
  - i. Continuously active within the system, with no inactive periods of greater than 90 days
  - j. Have and maintain a current provider card in each of the following:
    - i. PALS
    - ii. PHTLS
    - iii. ACLS
7. Critical Care Nurse / PHRN (tier 2-3 EMS licensed vehicle providers)
- a. Complete each system offered Continuing Education (CE) skills education
  - b. Complete any Medical Director mandated education by deadline
    - i. All quarterly intubations
  - c. Complete 12 hours of Critical Care Education annually
  - d. Complete skills competencies annually
  - e. Be under no current disciplinary action
  - f. Have a current Healthcare Provider CPR card
  - g. Have a current IDFPR RN license as well as a current PHRN license
  - h. Have met the annual skills requirements for PHRN's.
  - i. Continuously active within the system, with no inactive periods of greater than 90 days
  - j. Have and maintain a current provider card in each of the following:
    - i. PALS
    - ii. PHTLS
    - iii. ACLS

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
